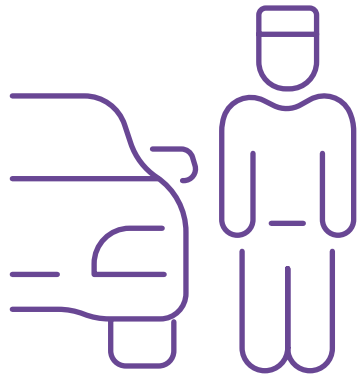

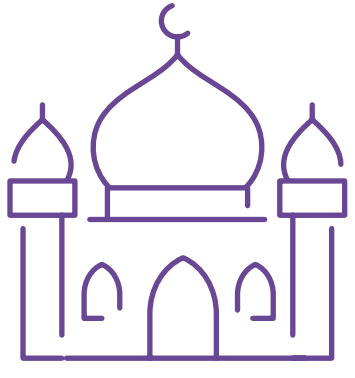

- Media center.

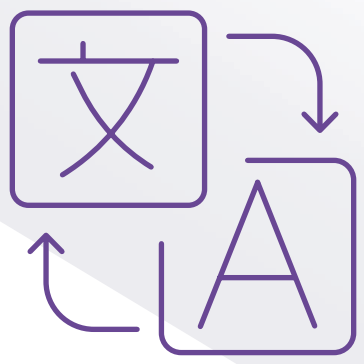

How to Reach the Conference Venues:

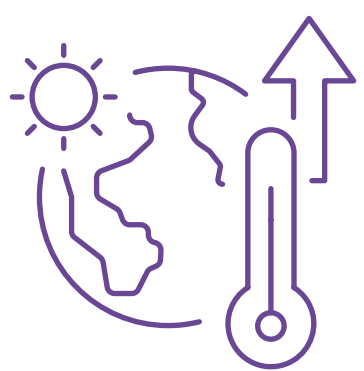
- **For International Participants:** Private transportation will be arranged to and from the airport, as well as between the Hotels and the conference venues.
