



Statement

The Muslim World League commended the United States for targeting and killing Al-Qaeda leader Ayman Al-Zawahiri, a symbol of international terrorism who planned and executed terrorist attacks that claimed the lives of thousands of people around the world.

His Excellency the Secretary General of the Muslim World League, Chairman of the Organization of Muslim Scholars, Sheikh Dr. Mohammad bin Abdulkarim Al-Issa, stressed that this was an important step in the effort to eliminate Al-Qaeda, a terrorist organization guilty of committing heinous crimes against humanity.
